### Engineering geological conditions and problems:

The buildings from Roman times are founded on Upper Pleistocene gravels and sand.

Foundation problems and damages are not known.

### Other information:

Augusta treverorum, later to be known as Trier, was founded by the Romans under Emperor Augustus around 16 B.C. close to a place sacred to the Celtic Treveri tribe.

Trier was the first "town" north of the Alps to bear that label with justification.
